Compensation

Fee per contribution:

• **1.5 hours: €200**

• **3.0 hours: €300**

If there are multiple speakers, the fee will be divided accordingly.

Travel expense reimbursement

The following travel expense reimbursement rules apply to contributors (distance from Leipzig):

• **travel by car:** €0.30 per kilometre

• **arriving by train:** reimbursement of the cost of one **2nd class** ticket

• **Public transport:** reimbursement upon presentation of the relevant **receipts**

Maximum reimbursement: €170

If needed, you can book an overnight accommodation from **the hotel allotments of Leipziger Messe**. The costs for **one overnight accommodation (max. EUR 120)** per contribution will be covered.

All accepted abstracts will be published on the **congress website**.
